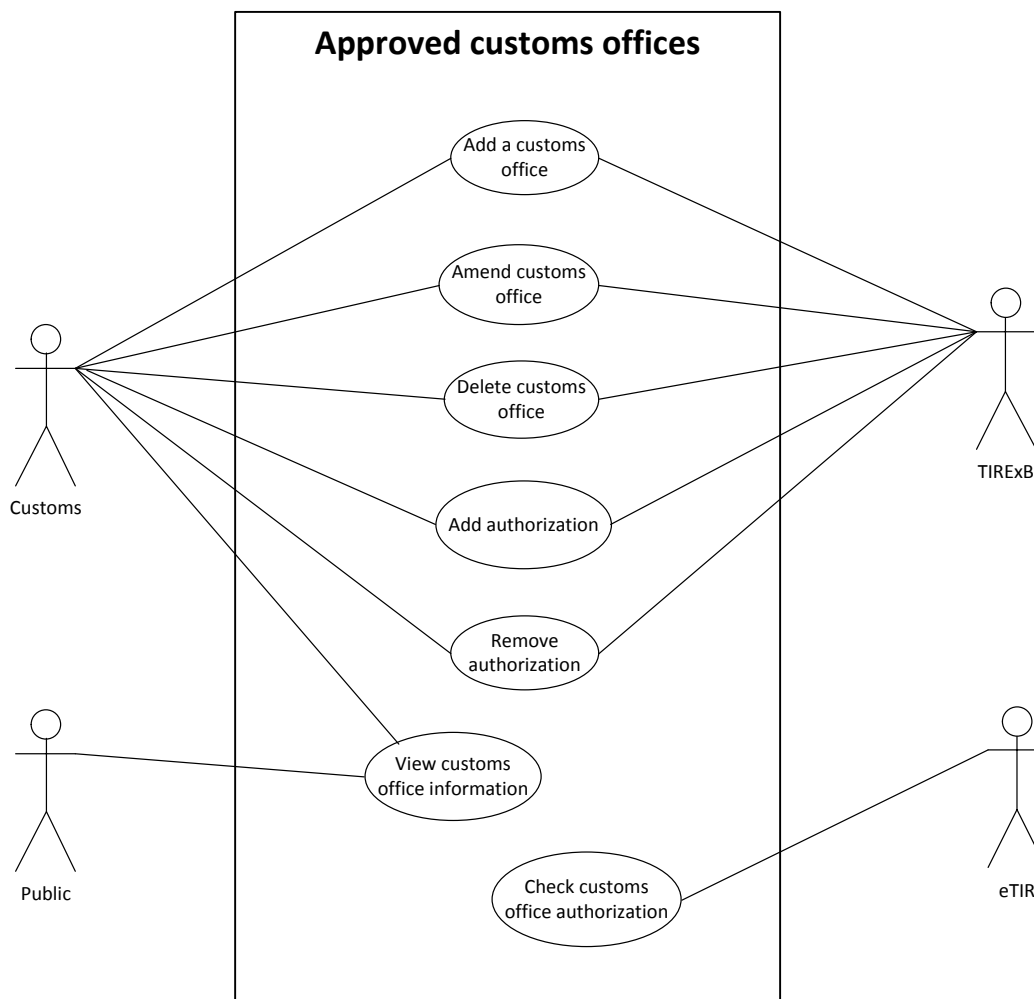
Background

- GE.1 : Customs office database is a building block of eTIR
- TIRExB Terms of Reference
 - 8. The TIR secretariat, under the direction of the TIR Secretary, shall undertake the following tasks:
 - (a) Establishment and maintenance of an international Governmental TIR data bank accessible to all Contracting Parties on:
 - approved Customs offices for accomplishing TIR operations (article 45)
- TIRExB recommended requested AC.2 to confirm this mandate (TIRExB/REP/2013/55, para. 42)
- **ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/2014/4**
 - Project Brief
 - Analysis of use cases and data

Actors

Actor	Responsibilities/rights
Customs authorities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add, amend and delete TIR (eTIR) customs offices in their customs territory • Indicate procedures that can take place at those offices (roles) • Indicate opening hours and excluded traffic/goods • Consult any information in other countries.
TIRExB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Amend the database on the basis of information received from Custom authorities
General public	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consult information
eTIR international system	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check customs offices authorization

Roles of customs offices

- TIR CO of departure
- TIR CO of destination
- TIR CO en route (entry/exit)
- eTIR CO of departure
- eTIR CO of destination
- eTIR CO en route (entry/exit)
- Issuance of certificates of approval
- Renewal of certificates of approval
- Endorsement of the rectification of defects

Updating mechanisms

- Automated update mechanisms that would push data from the National IT system to the TIRExB customs office database (web services)
- Manual update by customs administration using a web interface
- On an exceptional basis (backup), sending the information to the TIR Secretariat in electronic format

Each method requires resources from customs administration to keep the database up-to-date

Next steps

- AC.2
 - mandate TIRExB to start to work on the Customs office Database (task already mentioned in the TIRExB Terms of Reference) with the current resources
 - Confirm the absence if issues related to data protection
- TIRExB
 - Finalize the analysis (together with interested parties) taking into account existing systems (e.g. EU COL)
 - Development and testing
 - Integration in the ITDB security framework
 - Deployment to Contracting Parties (requires the involvement of each country to keep the data up-to-date)
