ACTIVITIES AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE TIR EXECUTIVE BOARD (TIRExB)

**Identification (ID) number of the TIR Carnet holder and access
to the International TIR Data Bank (ITDB)**

Note by the secretariat

1. The ITDB contains at present more than 33,000 persons/companies authorized by national Customs authorities to utilize the TIR procedure. It also contains information on persons excluded from the TIR procedure in accordance with Article 38 of the Convention. At present, only so-called “contact information” is released to facilitate inquiry procedures by Customs authorities.
2. The Administrative Committee at its thirty-sixth session, urged all Contracting Parties to respect the provisions of Annex 9, Part II, paras. 4 and 5 of the Convention concerning transmission of ITDB data, with a view that the ITDB becomes a value added tool for Customs authorities. In this context, and bearing in mind that the ITDB on line web interface which will provide Customs TIR Focal points with an on-line access to update and consult the ITDB, is technically ready to be launched (TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/2004/17), the Committee may wish to be informed of the status of the transmission of data to the ITDB.

3. In 2004, 33 Contracting Parties (see Annex) have complied with Annex 9, Part II, Article 5, transmitting an updated list of all authorized persons as well as of persons whose authorization has been withdrawn, 30 of them also regularly sending information concerning newly authorized TIR Carnet Holders as well as modifications regarding TIR Carnet Holders who have already been authorized.
4. 11 Contracting Parties have not complied in the year 2004 even if they have sent data in the previous years.
5. 3 Contracting Parties with which a TIR transit operation can be established have informed the secretariat that, for the time being, they do not have authorized TIR Carnet Holders.
6. In spite of various reminders sent by the TIR secretariat, 5 Contracting Parties have so far, not sent as of today, any information concerning their authorized TIR Carnet users.
7. The Administrative Committee may wish to consider how to improve the transmission from those Contracting Parties which do not comply with Annex 9, Part II, Article 4 and/or Article 5 of the TIR Convention.
8. The Administrative Committee may also wish to consider if the ITDB online could be launched with the data of the 30 countries which are at present fully complying with the TIR Convention.
