International TIR Data Bank (ITDB)

Note by the TIR secretariat

- 1. The ITDB contains at present information on more than 40,000 persons/companies authorized by national Customs authorities to utilize the TIR procedure and almost 17,000 persons/companies who have been withdrawn from the TIR system or have decided to end their TIR activities. It also contains information on persons excluded from the TIR procedure in accordance with Article 38 of the Convention. The information contained in the ITDB can be consulted on-line by Customs TIR Focal Points and by Customs officials provided that the national TIR Customs Focal Point has requested the TIR secretariat to authorize them.
- 2. The Administrative Committee may wish to recall, that at its previous sessions, it had urged all Contracting Parties to respect the provisions of Annex 9, Part II, paras. 4 and 5 of the Convention concerning transmission of ITDB data with a view that the ITDB becomes a value added tool for Customs authorities (TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/89, para. 17). It also stressed that it is important that Contracting Parties, if at all possible, transmit data in electronic form with a view to ensuring efficient and timely transmission and processing of data.
- 3. Considerable efforts have been made by the TIR secretariat to receive from Contracting Parties update information. At present 93% of Contracting Parties sends regularly information updates to the TIR secretariat.
- 4. In this context, the Committee may wish to be informed of the status of the transmission of legally required documentation. The following table shows the status of the transmission of data to the ITDB in compliance with Annex 9, Part II, Para. 5, and the status of transmission of statutory information concerning insurance contracts, which is required at the beginning of each calendar year.
