TIR-EPD Progress

- Major progress was achieved since last GE.1 session held in March 2011 with 15 countries now in operation!
- 4 new countries are newly operational on TIR-EPD:
 - Belgium, France, Germany, Moldova
- 3 successful pilots with expected imminent going live expected:
 - Belarus, Bosnia-Herzegovina and Serbia
- Following additional 6 countries are currently in development in the further implementation of TIR-EPD:
 - Georgia (in partnership with UNCTAD), Morocco, Netherland, Russia, Ukraine and Turkey
- 7 further countries signalled concrete interest
 - Albania, Greece, Iran, Kazakhstan, Kirghizstan, Macedonia and Uzbekistan
- 50% submission increase up to more than 1'700 per week




TIR-EPD Geographical Coverage

 - Uzbekistan



TIR-EPD monthly Statistics






Real-Time SafeTIR Progress

- Here also, major progress was also achieved since last GE.1 session held in March 2011
- 3 new countries are now operational on RTS:
 - Moldova, Turkey and Georgia (in partnership with UNCTAD)
- Turkey alone is transmitting up to 2000 records per day
- Following 2 countries are currently in development in the further implementation of RTS:
 - Belarus and Morocco
- 6 further countries signalled concrete interest
 - Albania, Azerbaijan, Finland, Latvia, Lithuania and Uzbekistan


