Background

- Further to UNECE-IRU meeting on 15 February 2011
- Proposals to :
 - **amend the guarantee validation mechanism (ECE/TRANS/WP.30/2011/5)**
 - **June 2011 : WP.30 request to GE.1 to reconsider the proposal considering the eTIR FP views (ECE/TRANS/WP.30/GE.1/2011/8)**
 - introduce international declaration mechanisms

Background

- The acceptance of the guarantee (I1) is sent by Customs to the eTIR international system to indicate that a guarantee will be used for a transport.
- The validation of the guarantee takes place as part of the acceptance mechanism.
- The validation ensures that the guarantee is valid at the moment of acceptance.

Current procedure (WP.30/2011/4)

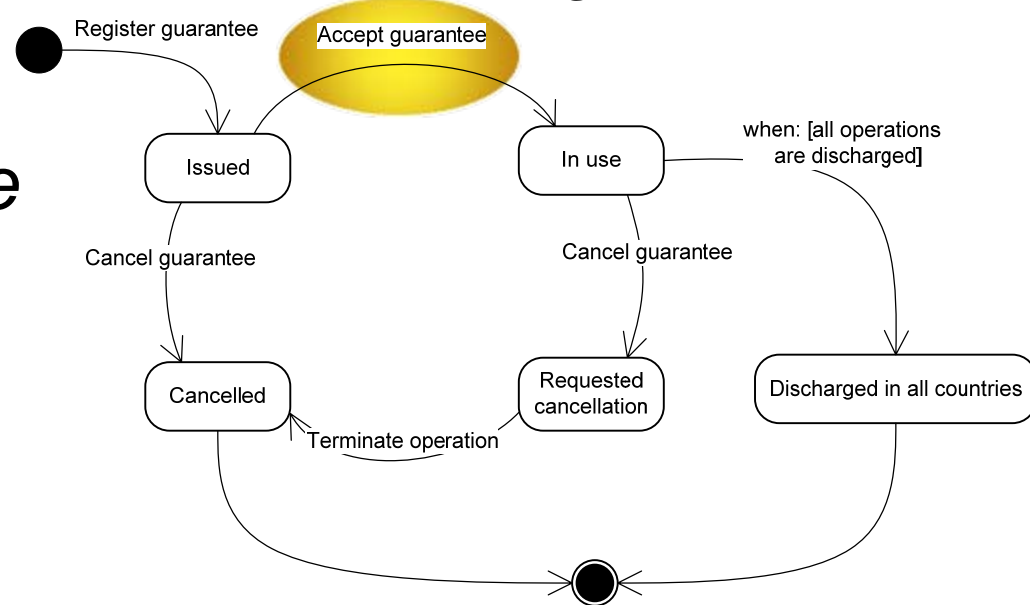


- 1 Guarantee registration
- 2 Guarantee acceptance
- 3 Acceptance results

Proposal

- *The validation of guarantees that have not been used or cancelled will be made via the eTIR international system against the guarantee chain database.*

Guarantee state chart diagram

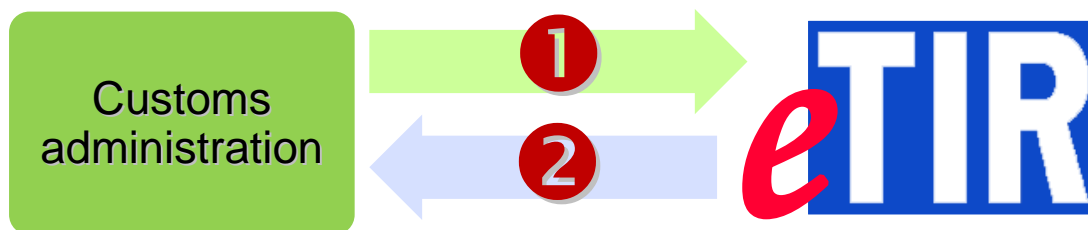


Proposed procedure (WP.30/2011/5)

- Validation (and query) of un-used and un-cancelled guarantees



- In other cases



eTIR focal points recommendations

- 6 eTIR focal points expressed their support for the proposal
- 1 could not support the proposal
 - Rationale: unnecessary complication
