INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE HARMONIZATION OF FRONTIER  
CONTROLS OF GOODS

GENEVA, 21 OCTOBER 1982

PROPOSAL OF A NEW ANNEX 9 TO THE CONVENTION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 30 August 2010, the Administrative Committee for the International Convention on the Harmonization of Frontier Controls of Goods of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) transmitted to the Secretary-General, in accordance with the provisions of article 22 of the above-mentioned Convention, a proposal for a new Annex 9 to the Convention, adopted at its ninth session held in Geneva on 27 May 2010.
