- Available in 11 languages
- Available for Customs and associations TIR Focal Points

ITDB2001 structure



ITDBonline

- A multilingual web application to consult the ITDB (13 languages)
- Access restricted to Customs TIR Focal Points and authorized Customs officers
- Secured using password and scratch list





Online Register of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps



- Multilingual web application – Russian, French, English
- International register for 67 TIR Contracting Parties
- Access restricted to authorized Customs officers



ITDBonline+



- Under development
- Real time update of the ITDB information
- Accessible to authorized Customs officers and national associations

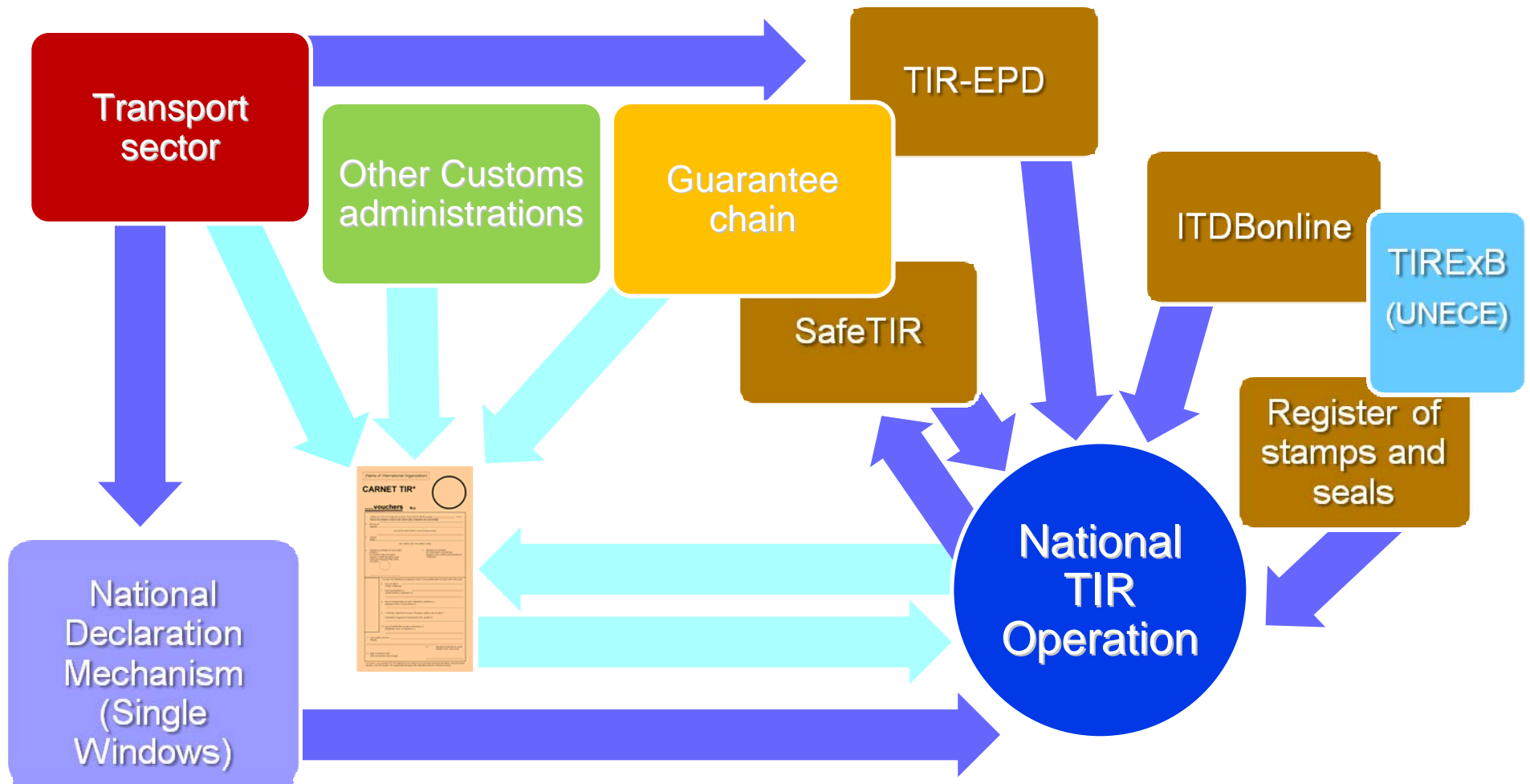

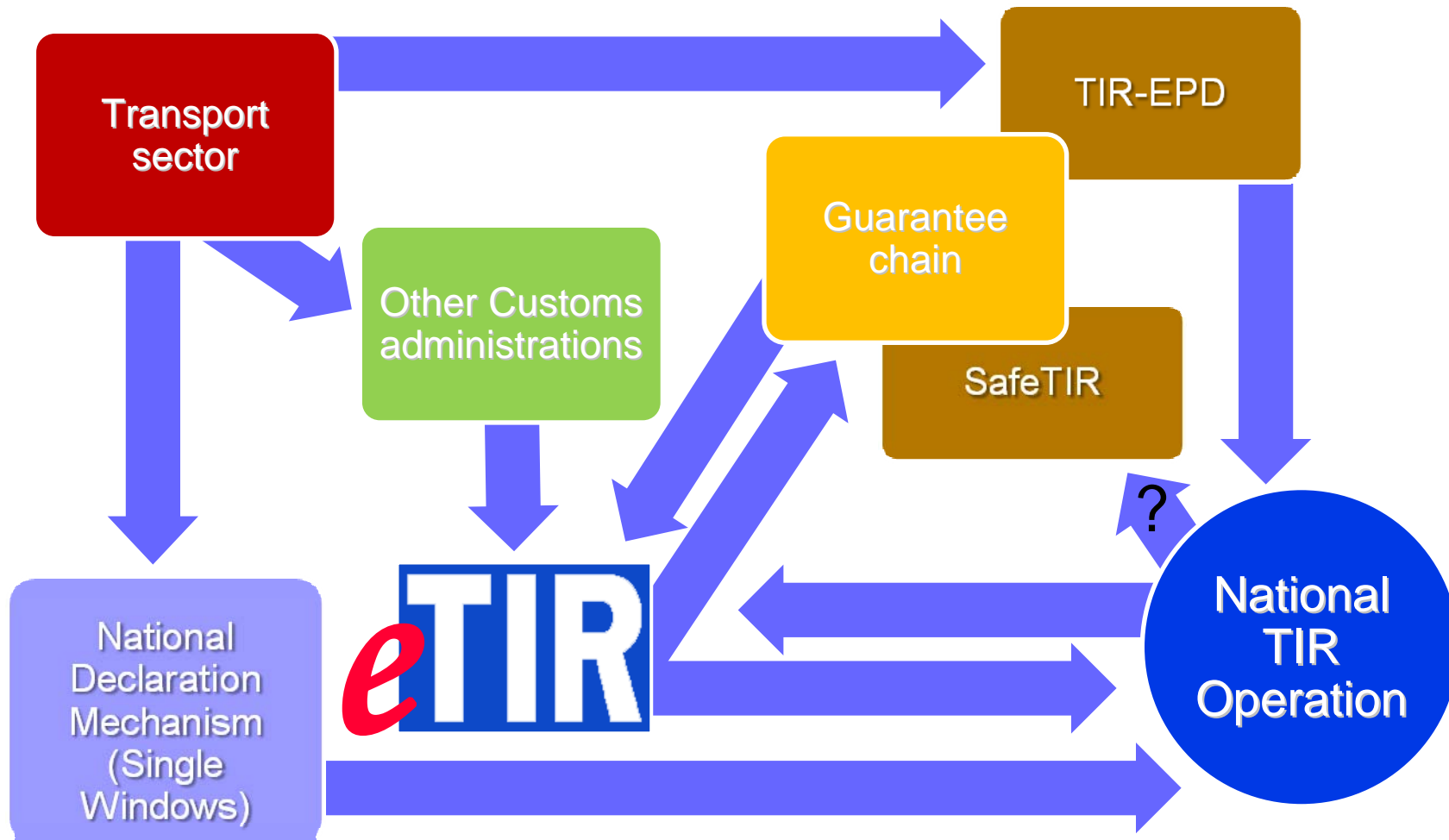
IRU tools

- SafeTIR / CuteWise / RTS
 - Provide TIR operation termination data at unloading places to the guarantee chain (risk management)
- TIR – EPD
 - International advanced declaration web application (one declaration at the time)
- ...

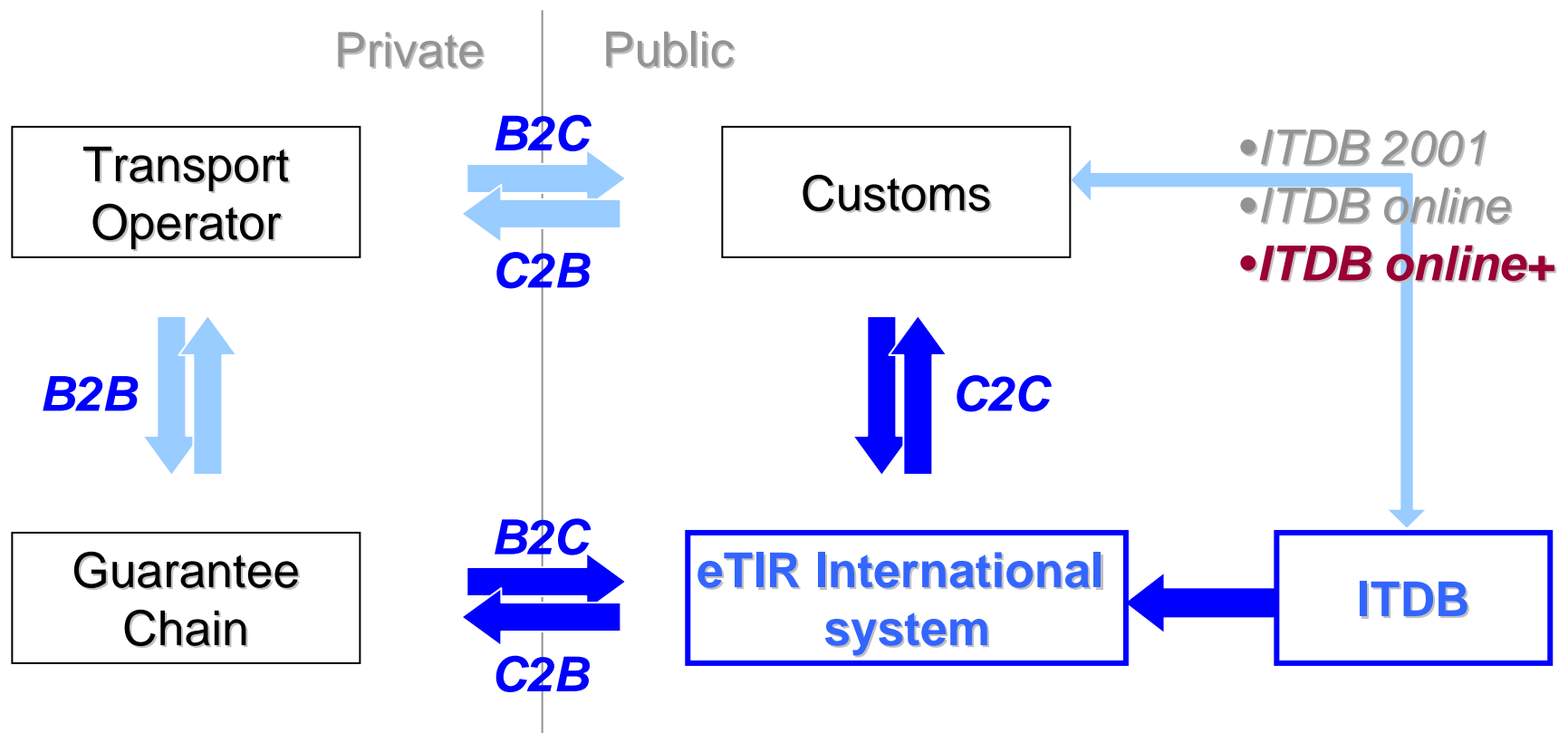


Fully computerized eTIR system





eTIR system



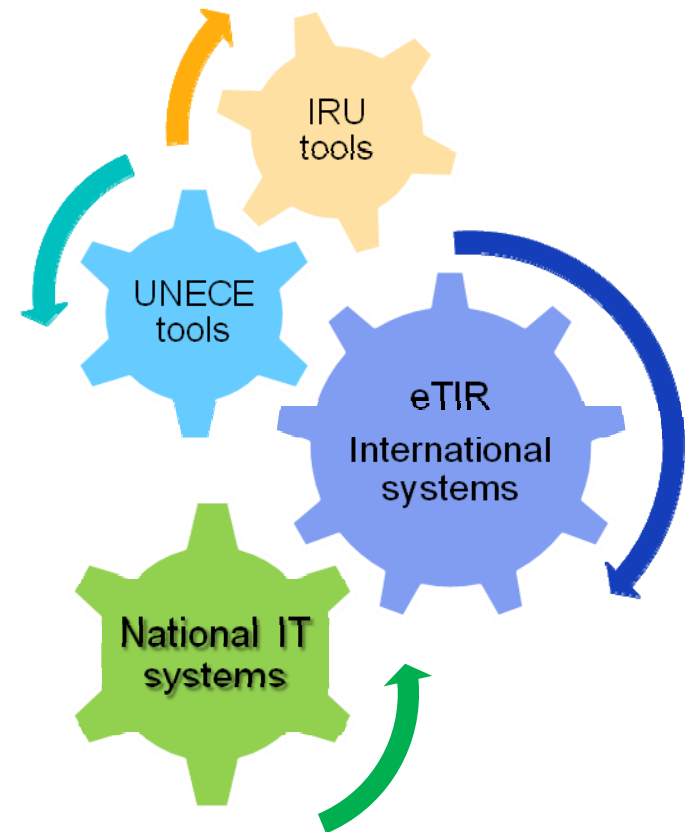
