


TIR-EPD Progress

- Major progress was achieved since last WP-30 session held in February 2011
- 4 new countries are now operational on TIR-EPD:
 - Belgium, France, Germany, Moldova
- 50% submission increase up to 1'631 last week
- Following 9 countries are currently in development in the further implementation of TIR-EPD:
 - Belarus, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Georgia (in partnership with UNCTAD), Morocco, Netherland, Russia, Serbia, Ukraine and Turkey
- 6 further countries signalled concrete interest
 - Albania, Greece, Iran, Kazakhstan, Macedonia and Uzbekistan

 - Uzbekistan




Real-Time SafeTIR Progress

- Here also, major progress was also achieved since last WP-30 session held in February 2011
- 2 new countries are now operational on RTS:
 - Moldova, Turkey
- Turkey alone is transmitting up to 2000 records per day
- Following 3 countries are currently in development in the further implementation of RTS:
 - Belarus, Georgia (in partnership with UNCTAD) and Morocco
- 6 further countries signalled concrete interest
 - Albania, Azerbaijan, Finland, Latvia, Lithuania and Uzbekistan

 Great progress achieved thanks to close partnership with Contracting Parties


Further significant progress expected this year
