



GTR Classifications

- ✦ Category 1 - Passenger Vehicles
 - ✦ Category 1-1 - not more than 8 passengers
 - ✦ Category 1-2 - more than 8 passengers
- ✦ Category 2 - Goods Vehicles



Existing UN/ECE Classifications

- ✦ Category M - Passenger Vehicles
 - ✦ Category M1 - not more than 8 passengers
 - ✦ Category M2 - more than 8 passengers $\leq 5t$
 - ✦ Category M3 - more than 8 passengers $> 5t$
- ✦ Category N - Goods Vehicles
 - ✦ Category N1 - $\leq 3.5t$
 - ✦ Category N2 - $>3.5t \leq 12t$
 - ✦ Category N3 - $> 12t$

Light Truck - ?



If a vehicle meets all of the following conditions:

$$P - (M + N \times 68) > N \times 68,$$

$$N \leq 6 \text{ and}$$

Pay mass as defined in paragraph 7. of annex 3 exceeds 150 kg for the vehicle, as configured with the maximum mass of factory fitted optional equipment,

the vehicle shall be deemed to be a category 2 vehicle.
