TRANSPORT DOCUMENT Composition of gas mixtures (5.4.1,2.2)

Transmitted by the European Liquefied Petroleum Gas Association (AEGPL)

In INF.4, Poland and Austria propose to reintroduce for UN 1010, UN 1060, UN 1078 and UN 1965 the exemption from the requirement of paragraph 5.4.1.2.2 (a), i.e. requirement to indicate the 2 major components (with percentages) in the transport document.

AEGPL fully supports this request as the LPG products are commonly known by their technical names, which are already indicated in the transport documents and which can precisely define the relevant product characteristics by referencing "Mixture C" etc. Moreover, these components have similar physical properties and belong to the same class, with the same classification code and the same label inside ADR.

The additional indication of components (with percentages) in the transport document is therefore redundant.
