#### **Amsterdam Declaration: Vision for THE PEP**

- 4 THE PEP Priority Goals
  - Invest in environment-and health-friendly transport
  - Manage sustainable mobility
  - Reduce emissions
  - Promote proper design of urban areas and transport infrastructure (focus on children and elderly)
- New THE PEP work plan (2009-2014)
  - Exchange of best practices
  - Capacity building
  - Outreach to regional and local levels
  - Monitoring and reporting



#### **Amsterdam Declaration: Vision for THE PEP**

- New THE PEP Implementation Mechanisms
  - National THE action plans (NTHEAPs)
  - THE PEP relay race ("staffette")
    Amsterdam Prague (23-25.09.2009)
  - THE PEP partnerships
- THE PEP Institutional Framework
  - Confirm role of UNECE secretariat (Transport and Environment Divisions)
  - Confirm role of WHO/Europe secretariat
  - Confirm role of Steering Committee and Bureau
  - Voluntary resource mechanism based on projects
