8.6.1.3 Model for a certificate of approval for tank vessels and 8.6.1.4 Model for a provisional certificate of approval for tank vessels

Transmitted by the Government of Austria 1,2

1. The models for the certificate of approval for tank vessels and the provisional certificate of approval for tank vessels list closed and partly closed sampling devices and sampling openings as additional equipment. In accordance with 9.3.1.21.1, 9.3.2.21.1 and 9.3.3.21.1 tank vessels do not have to carry a closed or a partly closed sampling device on board. They have to be equipped
