Proposal for Supplement 5 to Regulation No. 86  
(Installation of lighting and light-signalling devices for agricultural or forestry tractors)

Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) \*/

The text reproduced below was adopted by GRE at its sixtieth session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2008/54, as amended by Annex VIII to the report. It is submitted to WP.29 and AC.1 for consideration (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/60, para. 42).

\*/ In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2006-2010 (ECE/TRANS/166/Add.1, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Paragraph 6.2.11., amend to read:

"6.2.11. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

The requirements of paragraph 5.5.2 shall not apply to the passing lamps.

Passing beam headlamps with light source(s) producing the principal dipped beam (as defined in Regulation No. 48) and having a total objective luminous flux which exceeds 2,000 lumens are prohibited."
