Note by the Recommended ADN Classification Societies

1. While examining certain technical points, it is thought to have been discovered that the same thing is named differently in two cases in the ADN:
 2. In the definition of "sampling opening", the expression "flame arrester" is used.
 3. In the text of 9.3.3.21.9, third paragraph, the expression "**Screens** in sampling openings" is used. It is thought that this should read "**Flame arresters** in sampling openings".
 4. There is the same problem in French with "élément coupe-flamme".in the definition and "Le tamis" in 9.3.3.21.9, third paragraph.
