WE DO NOT SPEED

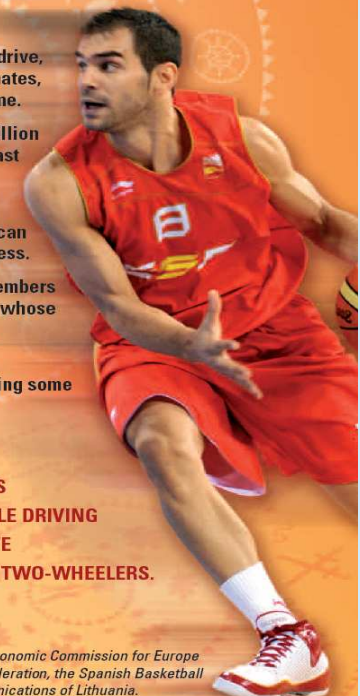
WE ALWAYS WEAR SEAT BELTS
