The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

I. Proposal

Add new aragraph 5.8 to read:

"5.8. To obtain type approval according this Regulation is required possibility to install lamp in question at least on one type of vehicle according requirements of Regulation No 48.

II. Justification

Because in Regulation No7 there are not requirements regarding change of luminance of lamp it is possible to obtain type approval for lamps which cannot be mounted on vehicle according Regulation 48. But such lamps can be used as aftermarket parts and could be installed on used vehicles. This proposal is intended to protect against such situation.
