## **Statistics on passenger transport by buses and coaches**

### **Note by the secretariat**

1. The Working Party may wish to consider the data availability for the pilot questionnaire on passenger transport by buses and coaches circulated through the Web Common.

### **Data availability**

2. By the end of April 2012, 17 countries had delivered data: Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Germany, Estonia, Finland, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden and the United States of America. At the same period in 2011, 21 countries replied to this pilot questionnaire: Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Germany, Estonia, Finland, France, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Republic of Moldova, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and the United States of America.

3. The total number of countries which replied to the pilot questionnaire reached 25.

4. The most available data are related to the number of passengers as well as the number of vehicle-km.

5. The number of countries having provided data is presented in the table below showing the number of replies corresponding to each entry in the pilot questionnaire.
