# Proposal for collective amendments to Regulations Nos. 53 and 74

### Submitted by the expert from Italy\*

The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from Italy to delete all obsolete references in Regulations 53 and 74 to avoid confusion and possible incorrect application of the requirement containing these references. The modifications to the existing text of the Regulation are marked in bold for new or strikethrough for deleted characters.

In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2010–2014 (ECE/TRANS/208, para. 106 and ECE/TRANS/2010/8, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

#### I. Proposal

#### A. Proposal for amendments to Regulation No. 53

Paragraph 6.1.1. to 6.1.1.2. shall read:

- 6.1.1.1. For motorcycles having a cylinder capacity  $\leq 125 \text{ cm}^3$ 
  - One or two of approved type according to:
  - (a) Class B, C or D of Regulation No. 113;
  - (b) Regulation No. 112;

  - (d) Regulation No. 8;
  - (e) Regulation No. 20;
  - (f) Regulation No. 57;
  - (g) Regulation No. 72.
- 6.1.1.2. For motorcycles having a cylinder capacity  $> 125 \text{ cm}^3$

#### B. Proposal for amendments to Regulation No. 74

Paragraph 6.1.1. shall read:

- (b) Class A of Regulation No. 112;
- (c) Regulation No. 1;
- (d) Regulation No. 56;
- (e) Regulation No. 57;
- (f) Regulation No. 72;
- (g) Regulation No. 76;
- (h) Regulation No. 82."

#### II. Justification

- 1. During the sixty-ninth session of GRE, under item 5(f) of the agenda, a proposal to "freeze" Regulations Nos. 5 and 31 (see document ECE/TRANS/WP29/GRE/2013/5) was approved.
- 2. Consequently Italy presented an informal document deleting references to Regulation No. 31 presently existing in paragraphs 6.1.2. and 6.2.2. of Regulation No. 48.
- 3. The Netherland's expert suggested a check for similar references to "frozen" Regulations in other installation regulations (namely Regulations Nos. 53, 74 and 86) which has been made.
- 4. In the first two regulations there were no reference to Regulations Nos. 5 and 31 (object of the GTB proposal) but references to Regulations Nos. 1, 8, 20, 56, 57, 72, 76 and 82 all regulations already "frozen" and replaced by Regulations Nos. 112 and 113 were found.
- 5. In Regulation No. 86 no reference to other regulations exists for which the deletion is suitable.
- 6. With the present document Italy proposes to also delete all the above listed obsolete references to avoid confusion and possible incorrect application of the requirements containing these references.
