Project objectives



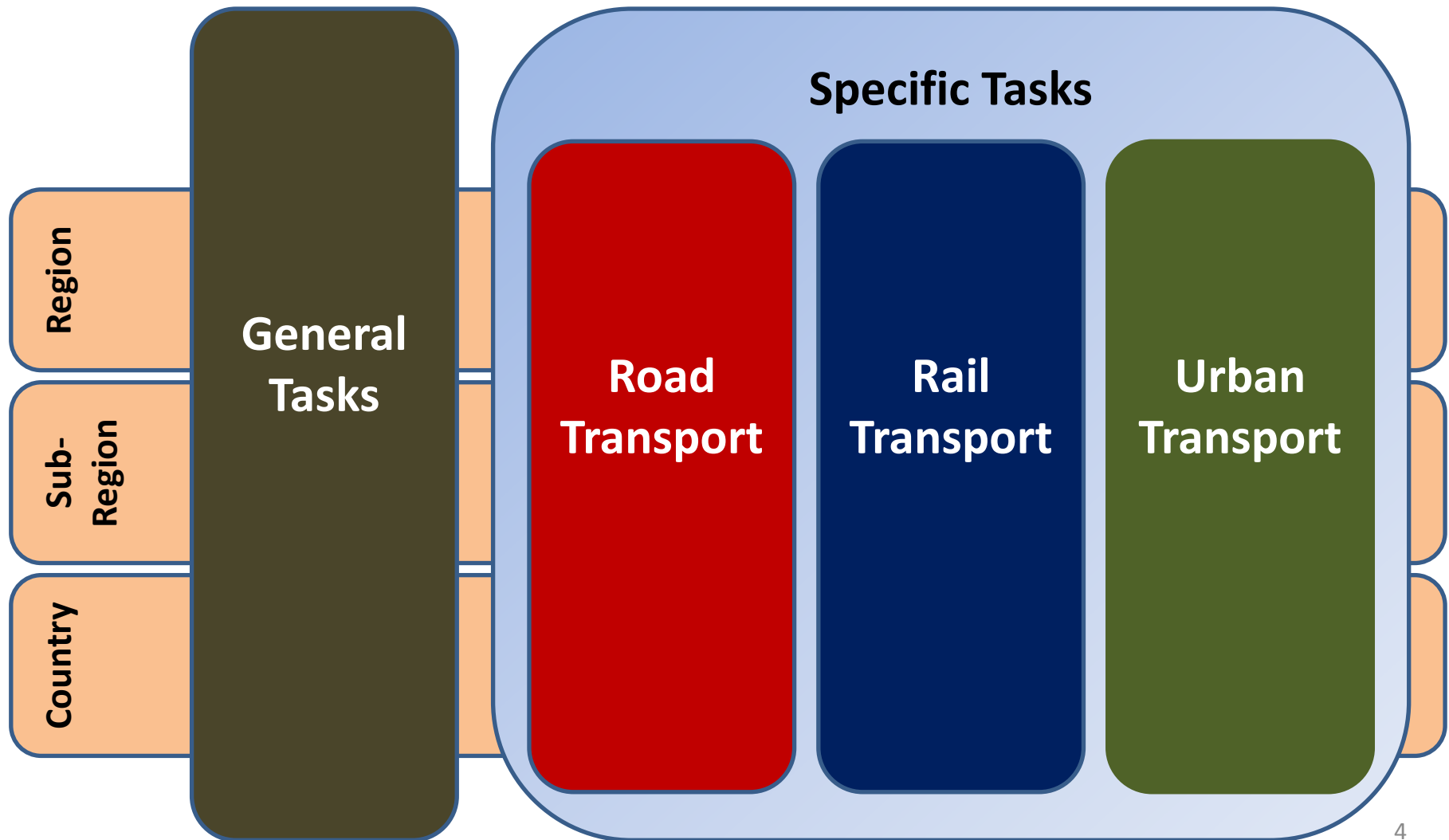
- **Land** transport along the Euro-Mediterranean RTAP

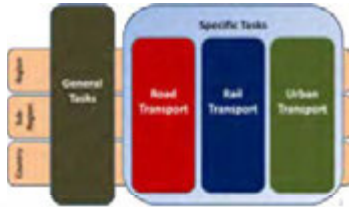
Structure of the Work Plan

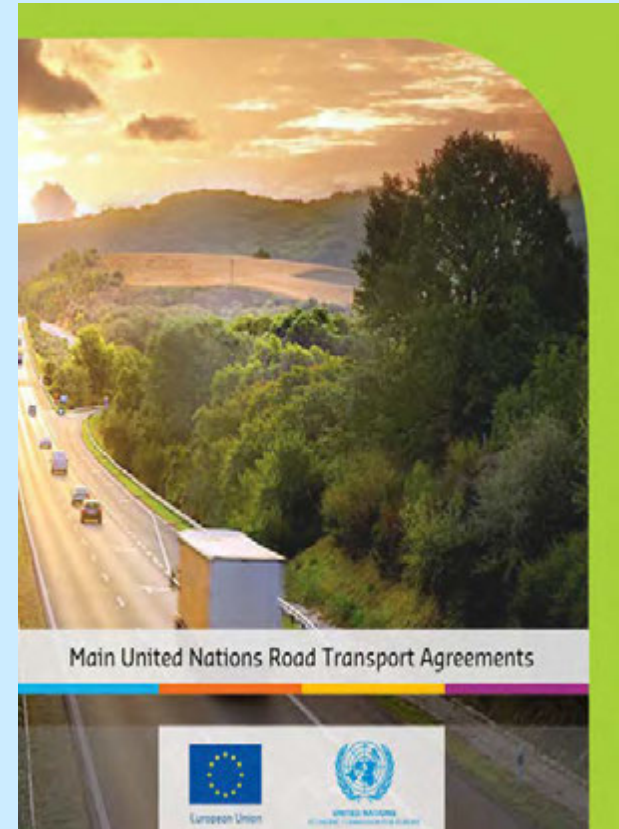

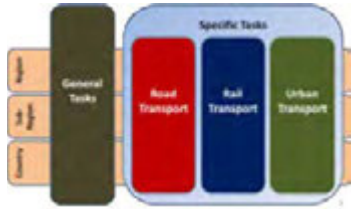


Sustainable results
