#### **Transport and Security**

#### Note by the secretariat

- 1. The Inland Transport Committee (ITC), at its sixty-fourth session (Geneva, 18 to 21 February, 2002) considered the issue of transport and security (TRANS/2002/15). The Committee requested its subsidiary bodies to identify, within their respective fields of competence:
- (a) the differences between the concepts "security" and "safety" and
- (b) the relevant concrete questions that could be addressed in this respect, taking into account the work and studies undertaken by other organs, in particular by the EMCT.

2. The Working Party is invited to consider the two above mentioned questions within its field of competence and, if possible, come to a conclusion on relevant follow-up action. In this context, delegations are invited to inform the Working Party of transport and security initiatives taken a national level, which are relevant to combined transport.
