#### PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

**IMPORTANT:** Due to renovation works at the Palais des Nations, there is a new location to pick up your entry badge to the UN campus (the Security Office at the Pregny Gate is closed). **Please allow at least one hour to pick up your badge and reach the meeting room.**

- To attend the meeting, you must register via the INDICO system. If you have not done so yet, please [REGISTER HERE](#). If you plan for the last-minute registration, please also notify about that fact the secretariat at [natural.gas@un.org](mailto:natural.gas@un.org) so that we do not miss your application.
- Due to renovation works at the Palais des Nations, your badge is to be picked up from a new location, i.e., “Villa les Feuillantines” (open from 8:00 to 16.45). Directions to the Villa are provided in the document “**Badge**”. **VERY IMPORTANT: Please allow at least one hour to obtain your entry badge and get to the meeting room. The walk from Villa les Feuillantines to the meeting room is around 10 minutes.** Delegates must present their national identification card (only for the Schengen zone nationals) or passport, as well as their registration confirmation paper with **QR code** (that you received together with an email confirmation that your registration was approved).
- The meeting will be held in the Tempus building, very close to the Peace Gate Bis (a new UN entrance at Place des Nations). Please see a map with instructions “**Tempus**”.
- Masks are no longer mandatory in conference rooms.
- Please bring a laptop or other electronic device should you wish to connect online and have access to the documents that are to be discussed at the meeting. For environmental reasons, to the extent possible, UN is trying to be paperless.
- Kindly note that outlets in Switzerland are different than in most countries and therefore please remember to bring adapters.
