


### **General ITDB data status**

- 2,851 TIR customs offices




## Active Contracting Parties with holder data




Active Contracting Parties with Customs or Nat. Associations users




Active Contracting Parties with stamps or seals data



- Approximately 138,000 web service calls per year in 2018 and 2019.
- 77,700 WS calls in 2020.
- 176,710 WS calls in 2021.
- **233,740 WS calls in 2022.**
- 110,087 WS calls so far in 2023.
