



Status of the new Online Reporting System (ORS) development

January 2024: Finalization of an update of the overall system of reporting by UNEP-WCMC

February–June 2024: Transfer of the Protocol questionnaire into the new UNEP-WCMC system (first MEA to be transferred)

July – August 2024: Finalization of fully functional Protocol Online Reporting System (including initial testing)

September – October 2024: Training sessions for the Protocol secretariat, Parties, and other States and possibly pilot testing

November 2024 – April 2025: Sixth reporting exercise under the Protocol on Water and Health / technical support by UNEP-WCMC
