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Current situation RSA in Serbia

RSA - Possible improvements

- RSA (RISM) is stated in Law on Public Roads but not in Law on Planning & Construction Some investors (only) refer to the Law on Planning & Construction – no RSA is conducted or only at the very last stages of the project
- RSA is not necessary for approval of a project by the Ministry of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure

including RISM in Law on Planning & Construction

RSA - Possible improvements

- Timing of the RSA; in some cases break in the design process and therefore also in the RSA process
 - Start of RSA in the initial stages of the project, results of NWA should be considered
- Awareness issues understanding the contents of RSA in different stages, overall objective
 - Awareness raising in training courses and during the whole process

RSA & RSI - Possible improvements

- Meanwhile enough Auditors and Inspectors certified
 Certification as sufficient proof of qualification in tenders
- Redundancies in reports; legal framework cited in reports, statistics on deficiencies and acceptance of recommendations
 - ➡ focus on the relevant issues safety issues
